OPAL enhancements- Parents needed.

We are looking for some parents who would be able to volunteer some of their time during half term on Monday 24th October 2022 from 9:00am- 1:00pm. We are looking to make some raised beds,



some pallet seating and need help to dig out some pathways, amongst other

things. If anyone has any power tools/drills etc that they can bring with them this would be very helpful. We don't mind if children attend, but this would be on the basis that parents are responsible for supervising them. We would obviously have access to toilets and would be able to provide hot drinks. We will confirm with the parents that volunteer that we are going ahead as we will need quite a few volunteers.

Writing workshops:

We are offering the chance for parents to come into school for writing workshops on the following dates:

Mental Health Support for children.

We now have some mental health practitioners working in school on a weekly basis. This service is provided by the NHS and is aimed at supporting pupils with low-level mental health concerns.

We are able to refer children into the service with parental consent. However, we aren't always aware of children who may benefit from the support of the mental health

practitioners as sometimes children can present and behave very differently in school compared to home. If you think your child might benefit from this service, please contact Mrs McAleny at school and we can

add your child to the waiting list or just provide some further information to help you make a decision as to whether it may benefit your child.

Mental Health Crisis Helpline

As part of the NHS Cheshire and Wirral Partnership there is a crisis helpline available which families can use if they are in need of urgent mental health support. Anyone can call and they will be able to speak to a mental health operative who will triage the call and signpost appropriately. Due to the volume of rain we have had recently, our school field is now quite muddy. Therefore, please ensure that your child has a pair of wellies or old trainers in school. Children will now not be permitted to go on the field unless they have wellies or old trainers as this also prevents mud/sand and dirt being brought back into school.
