#### **Christmas Fair:**

Many thanks for all the donations that were sent into school on Friday for the Christmas Fair. These donations really will make a huge difference to the success of the fair.

Our Christmas Fair is taking place on **Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2019.** For the first year, this event will run straight after school from **3:30pm-6:00pm**. The children will be dismissed as usual from the playground and then parents/children can make their way round to the front entrance of the school in order to gain entry for the fair.

If you are able to support at the fair, on a stall, please do make sure you have let the PTA know this. Any offers of support/help are really appreciated and will ensure that the fair can operate at full capacity. We look forward to seeing everyone on Friday at the fair.
