Office updates:

Messages for the school office.

If possible, please can parents contact the school office before 12:00pm to pass on any changes to collection arrangements at the end of the day. This means that all messages can be shared during the lunch time period with teaching staff and prevents the office staff from having to disturb lessons. We appreciate that this is not always possible, as there may be an emergency situation but if there are planned changes, please ensure that these are shared before 12:00pm.

Absences from school:

Please ensure that if your child is going to be absent from school that you report this promptly to the school office via phone or email: schooloffice@gayton.wirral.sch.uk. This supports the school office staff as they don't have to contact parents to find out why your child is not in school and saves valuable office time.

Medical appointments in school time.

Our attendance policy asks that where possible all medical appointments are made outside school hours. However, we do appreciate that this is not always possible. For an absence to be authorised as a medical appointment, we do require evidence such as appointment letters or text messages from your GP surgery. These can either be shown to the office staff when you come to collect your child or alternatively you can email the appointment letter into the school office when you are notifying us of the appointment.

Use of the school car park.


