As you will be aware, your child will be sitting their SAT tests next week in school. Below you will find an overview of the SATs timetable for next week.

We know that some children will be nervous or a little anxious about the tests whilst others won't be concerned at all. All children are different and we will do our very best to deliver the tests in a way that does not cause additional anxiety for your child. We are proud of all our children and just want them to do their best and nothing more can be asked of them than this.

Monday 8th May 2023- School not open- Bank Holiday

Tuesday 9th May 2023 - SPAG Paper 1- 9:15am & SPAG Paper 2 (10:45am)

Wednesday 10th May 2023- Reading test 9:15am

Thursday 11th May 2023- Maths Arithmetic paper 9:15am & Paper 2 (11:00am) Friday 12th May 2023- Maths Paper 3- 9:30am

If your child is ill on the day of the tests, please phone the school office to speak to me. It is vital that you don't send your child into school if they are not well. We can make arrangements for your child to sit them later in the week when they are feeling well. All this is possible, as long as parents communicate with us, so we can inform STA and apply for a timetable variation. In this circumstance, we would also need reassurance that you would ensure that your child does not have any contact (face to face or via phone/ virtual world of gaming) with any of the other Y6 pupils.

Please ensure your child is in school for 8:50am. Whilst some of the tests don't start until 9:15am/9:30am, we do have a lot of pre-organisation in relation to ensuring they have all gone to the toilet and have all the appropriate equipment etc.
