Dear Parents & Carers,

Welcome back to the start of the Spring 2<sup>nd</sup> half term.

#### Reminder: Year 4 times table workshop for parents and children:



All Year 4 children have to sit a statutory times table assessment in the summer term. This assessment takes places online and is a timed assessment. Y4 parents can find out more about the Y4 times table assessment by attending the parent/child workshop, which will take place on: **Monday 6th March 2023 at 9:00am.** This will be led by Miss Sothern (maths leader).We understand that not all parents will be able to attend due to other commitments so will send out information to parents who are unable to attend.

#### **Parents' Evening:**

Many thanks to everyone for attending parents' evening. After a few years of restrictions (due to covid), it is always lovely to welcome parents into school so that you can meet with teachers and also see your child's books and the outcomes from all their hard work. If you were unable to attend, please contact the school office to schedule an appointment with your child's class teacher.

#### Parking concerns in the local area:

The parking situation around school continues to concern me. Despite requests and communication sent to parents, we still have a number of parents who are not considering the safety of **all our children and families** and continue to park



or drive in an inconsiderate way in the local area. This includes: stopping to drop children off in the bus stop, parking opposite school and parking on double yellow lines further down Gayton Road.

We have been working closely with an Active Travel Officer from Wirral Borough Council and they have visited school in order to observe the traffic issues themselves. We are waiting for feedback from the council regarding any further suggestions that can be put in place to support the issue in the local area. However, we continue to work towards the Modeshift STARS National Accreditation programme and hope that we will be able to influence behaviour change amongst our school community with regards to parking.

In the meantime, I would urge parents to really consider where they are parking and think about the safety of all our children and families. Thank you to all our families that already do this on a daily basis, your cooperation with this matter is very much appreciated.

#### **Punctuality:**

All children should be in school by **8:50am**. It is vital that your child is in school by this time, so that they can be present for registration and have time to settle into class before lessons commence. Teachers also use this time to set activities before school starts so it really is vital that your child is on time to help them maximise their learning as well.

#### Holidays in term time:

Please can we remind all parents that children should not be taken out of school for holidays in term time unless due to truly exceptional circumstances. It is very rare that any holiday would be authorised. Good attendance is key to children making good progress and taking time out to go on holiday can significantly hamper progress. We are seeing an increase in the number of holiday requests and would urge parents to consider the impact of this on your child's learning. If your child's attendance is below 90%, they are classed as persistently absent from school. We will contact you to discuss this and put in any additional support needed. Persistent absence can also result in a fixed fine.

#### **PTA Donations:**


Gayton Primary PTA is a registered charity (1168184). We would be very grateful for any donation big or small. Every little helps towards buying great things for our lovely children.
