Y6 Robinwood Residential

National Statutory Testing 2022

National statutory testing begins this year after two years disrupted by Covid-19. Below we have shown an outline of the statutory testing that children will be completing in some year groups during the summer term. It is vital that your child is in school for these assessments.

Y1 Phonics screening- 6th June – 10th June 2022

Your child will complete the assessment with Miss Nederlof and they will be asked to read real and nonsense words. If your child doesn't pass the phonics screening check, they will take the test again in Year 2.

Y2- SATs- Taking place during May.

These will take place during May. The tests are usually completed in small groups and will be used to inform teacher judgements at the end of the year, alongside children's classwork.

Y4- Times table check- Check will be administered between 6th June- 24th June 2022 for Year 4 pupils.



This assessment takes place online and is a timed assessment. Y4 parents can find out more about the Y4 times table assessment by attending the parent/child workshop that will take place on: **Monday 4**th **April 2022 at 9:00am**. This will be led by Miss Sothern, our maths lead.

Y6 SATs tests - Monday 9th May 2022- Thursday 12th May 2022

Monday 9th May- Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation. Tuesday 10th May- Reading Wednesday 11th May- Maths- Paper 1 and Paper 2 Thursday 12th May- Maths- Paper 3.



Y6 parents can find out more about the Y6 SATs by attending the meeting for parents on: **Monday 21**st **March at 7:00pm.** This will take place in the school hall.

Our Y5/6 sports hall athletics team came 5th overall in the competition. Well done to everyone taking part.






Cross country team (Y4- Y6)

Covid-19 updates:

Our covid-19 cases are increasing at the moment. Please remember that if your child tests positive for covid-19, they must continue to isolate at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received 2 negative test results on consecutive days or until the 10th day. The flow chart below outlines when your child can return to school following their isolation period.

Sickness and Diarrhoea

It is common for children to experience sickness and diarrhoea at times. The NHS guidelines state that children should not return to school until 48 hours after their last bout of sickness/diarrhoea. We appreciate that this can be difficult for parents as sometimes your child can be sick once and then be absolutely fine. However, it is vital that parents do adhere to the 48 hours so that we can prevent it from spreading around the class.
