


### Covid-19 updates:

The last two weeks have been challenging from a staffing perspective due to the number of staff affected by covid. Our covid cases are decreasing again after they rose quite significantly last week, but please be vigilant and if your child displays any symptoms of covid-19, please do not send them to school.

Please remember that if your child tests positive for covid-19, they must continue to isolate at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received 2 negative test results on consecutive days or until the 10th day. The flow chart below outlines when your child can return to school following their isolation period.

We are awaiting the national changes to the guidance that will be coming into force at the end of March but currently we do not have any further information. We will share this with parents as soon as we can.

#### Sickness and Diarrhoea

It is common for children to experience sickness and diarrhoea at times. The NHS guidelines state that children should not return to school until 48 hours after their last bout of sickness/diarrhoea. We appreciate that this can be difficult for parents as sometimes your child can be sick once and then be absolutely fine. However, it is vital that parents do adhere to the 48 hours so that we can prevent it from spreading around the class.
