Curriculum information for the spring term & homework-

We will be sending home information regarding the curriculum in each year group on Monday 16th January 2023. This will support you in understanding what is being covered in your child's class during the term. Homework for the spring term will commence on Friday 13th January 2022. Please ensure that your child is reading daily at home. Reading is such an important element of your child's learning and it is vital that you, as parents, support in ensuring that your child is having regular opportunities to read at home.

Attendance: The DfE have a current renewed focus on pupil attendance. In order to ensure you are aware



of your child's attendance, we will send out an overview of your child's attendance from the autumn term by the end of this week. Attendance at school is important both academically and for social/emotional reasons. Whilst we understand that pupils will be absent from time to time due to illness, absence

from school for other reasons should only be for exceptional circumstances. Holidays taken in term time will not be authorised.

If your child's attendance falls below 90%, this is a concern as your child is classed as 'persistently absent'. When we have concerns about your child's attendance, we will contact you to discuss additional support to ensure your child's attendance improves. Parents can receive a fixed fine if their child's attendance is a concern as legally all children should be in school every day the school is open.

PTA fundraising update:

As part of our OPAL developments, we have a clear grounds development plan in place in order to ensure that we are strategically planning to improve the play provision for all our children. One of the key elements that we have identified on the plan is the need for the children to have greater opportunities for climbing within the school grounds. Therefore, our play team have been researching a variety of different ways in which we can best facilitate increasing climbing opportunities.

Thanks to the support of the PTA, we are pleased to announce that we will be working with Pentagon Play in order to install a Crinkle Crag climbing frame on our school field. This structure is perfect for all children within school and will enable them to enter and exit wherever they like and climb as high as they feel comfortable. Children will develop their overall body strength, coordination, core stability, balance, foot placement, grip and grasp and both their fine and gross motor skills. There will be plenty of space underneath the structure for den- making, reading and relaxation for children wanting a break from active play as well. Underneath the structure there will be appropriate safety surfacing to ensure that we meet all health and safety standards.

We are so thankful to the PTA and to all our parents for all their support of the PTA as without all their fundraising efforts and the support of the parental community this would not be possible. We are hoping that the Crinkle Crag will be installed at the end of April and will keep parents updated regarding the installation date. We know that this is going to be such a wonderful addition to our play provision and are so grateful to everyone for making this a possibility for our school community.





The PTA will now be fund raising for the second aspect of our grounds development plan which is the installation of a timber frame structure on the school playground. Through pupil surveys, our children have identified that there is no shelter available on the school playground either during hot or rainy weather. We would therefore like to install a timber structure enabling us to offer shelter and to support us in providing a quieter space for children to spend time in as well. This will be an ideal space for Lego play, craft activities etc as well.

We are hoping that everyone will unite in supporting the PTA so that we can raise the funds to allow us to make this a possibility. The cost of this structure with installation is around £15,000 so we need everyone to continue to support the PTA so that we can raise the money to facilitate this project.
