

What a wonderful day! Thank you to all our parents for supporting the children with their costumes for World Book day. All the children really did look wonderful.







Through the reading of the book, the children were transported to a different country and worked crafting their own penguin or polar bear design based on all the different countries in the story. We are going to be making a whole school display to showcase some of the excellent creative work from the day in the school hall.

Sponsored Read:



Liz from Usborne books came to our assembly on Friday to launch the sponsored read event. This event supports everything that we are doing in school to try and develop a genuine love of reading with our children. Your child should have come home with a sponsorship form on Friday along with a letter from the PTA about the event.





By participating in the sponsored read, it will enable us to buy some new non-fiction books for our library as well as some new guided reading books and independent reading books which are very much needed in school. Depending on the amount we raise through the sponsored read, Usborne will give us 60% more towards books for our school.



In order to take part in the sponsored read, the children need to read each day for the next week. The recommended time is 30 minutes but this can be entirely adapted to meet each child's needs and some children will want to read for a longer or shorter period of time.

Y4 workshop for parents- Multiplication tables check



All Year 4 children for the first time will have to sit a times table multiplication test. This will take place over a three week window in June commencing week beginning 8th June 2020. The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will help schools to identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided.

We would like to invite all Y4 parents to a workshop for parents regarding the multiplication check so that you can see what will be expected of your child and ideas for supporting them at home with preparing for this check.
