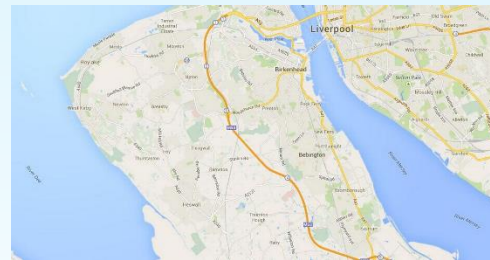

# Literacy

- Reading – free readers or reading scheme <http://www.lovereadings4kids.co.uk/>
- Reading with expression, discussing favourite words and phrases and making predictions and inferences
- Writing (themes – stories in familiar settings, historical stories, non-fiction texts and poetry)
- Spelling (contractions, suffixes, homophones, common exception words)
- Punctuation (basic punctuation, exclamation marks and question marks)
- Grammar -using conjunctions and expanded noun phrases
- Handwriting – cursive
- Alan Peat sentences ☺



# Mathematics



- Place value (tens and ones)
- Addition and subtraction (two-digit numbers and ones/tens using concrete objects/pictorial representations)
- Multiplication and division (2, 5 and 10x tables)
- Fractions (  $\frac{1}{2}$   $\frac{1}{4}$   $\frac{3}{4}$  )
- Measurement (telling the time, adding and subtracting money, measuring lengths, mass and volume)
- Shape (describe 2 and 3-D shapes and right angles as quarter/half turns)
- Statistics (using bar charts and pictograms and tables)
- Word problems involving all of the above.
- Calculation policy (see school website or see me for a hard copy).
