


# Newsletter 6- 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2022

### **Eco Schools Update Dec 2022**



There has already been a lot of work taking place in order to ensure that we achieve our Eco Schools Green Flag again this academic year. We are focusing on three key areas: Transport, Biodiversity and School Grounds.

We began by inviting everyone to bling their bikes and scooters. The response was tremendous and the bikes and scooters looked amazing. The children have had assemblies about World Car-free

day, road safety and the Highway Code. In addition, Year 5 completed their Bikeability training, with many children achieving Level 2.



Our whole school project this year is to achieve the **Woodland Trust Green Tree Award**. The Green Tree Schools Award encourages outdoor learning and inspires pupils to find out about trees, woods and wildlife. In order to gain the award, a variety of challenges have to be completed. Through the completion of the award, our school can take part in fun, practical projects while helping the environment and caring for our school grounds.

Throughout the year, each class will be responsible for completing different challenges. We have already completed several tasks. For example, the children in Year 5 planted a new hedgerow. They also helped their buddies to pot up some trees so that the roots can develop over the next few years before planting on our school field. Thanks to the contribution of Year 5 and F2, we found out this week that we have achieved the Bronze award. Many thanks to Mrs Hulley for all her hard work with coordinating this for our school.
