FULL STEAM AHEAD ...

Well we have had a busy few weeks with all the events that are planned for this half term! After a meeting with Mrs McAleny to discuss the schools "wish list" we have certainly ploughed on and made a really good go and getting as much as we can. Due to your continued support of the PTA and the events we hold we have managed to buy thirty of the following: Atlases, Dictionaries and Thesauruses for £1084, as well as a further thirty



glockenspiels and a storage trolley for £676.49 and two much needed Benchmark kits for £650.

Remaining on the "wish list" that we want to work towards is as follows ...

- Decodable phonics books (approx £2k)
- Independent reading books for KS2 (approx £4k)
- Guided reading books sets for KS1 & KS2 (approx £2k)
- Book sets for each year group for the new curriculum (approx £1300)
- Maths equipment (approx £1500)
- Fit a felt roof to the gazebo
- New shed for the stage blocks to be stored in as current is rotted and has holes in roof
- Carry out essential repairs to F2 outdoor classroom
- iPads (at least 8 more to enable a whole class to work at the same time plus ideally another 30 for F2)

As you can see - we have our work cut out and we really need your help and support!
