Term Time Leave of Absence:



We have been asked to circulate the following message on behalf of the Wirral Attendance Team...

Please be aware that the law around compulsory school attendance is now back in force since the start of the Autumn Term. This includes the regulations around leave of absence during term time. There continues to be no entitlement for parents to take their child out of school during term-time, unless this is completely unavoidable. Children have already lost so much teaching and learning time due to the coronavirus, and the priority now is for us to work together in the best interests of all children's education.

All schools within Wirral work closely with the Council on school attendance matters. The Council is fully committed to making sure that all children attend school and make the best possible progress.

Unauthorised holidays taken during term time can result in Penalty Notices being issued by the Council. As a school, this is something that we would wish to avoid and ask that any holidays be planned for school holiday periods.

Meetings with Parents

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, if any meetings take place with parents, they will need to take place outside. If we are unable to hold the meeting outside, it will need to take place via telephone or alternatively using Google Meet. This is completely against our school values and the ethos of the school but unfortunately I

need to do this to keep my staff and children safe. By limiting the number of people who access the school building, I am reducing the risk of transmission of the virus.

Harvest Festival



During the week commencing 19th October 2020, we will be holding our harvest festival. We will be collecting donations for the Wirral Food Bank. The children should bring donations into school from Monday 19th October- until Wednesday 21st October. There will

be collection banks for the children on entry to school by the Y5/6, Y3/4 and F2/Y1 & Y2 doors. We will then arrange for the items to be sent to the food bank. These are the items that the foodbank are in desperate need of at the current time: tinned meat, tinned vegetables, tinned fruit, custard & tinned fish. Please do not send any fresh food into school as the food bank cannot accept this.

COVID-19 updates:

Please can I remind all parents that only F2 parents should be coming onto the playground at the end of the day. If you need to speak to your child's class teacher, please wait until all the F2 parents have left the playground. This is to try and prevent too many people coming through the gate at once and ensures that everyone is kept safe.

Also, once your child has been dismissed from school, it is vital that parents leave the school area as quickly as possible as schools have been encouraged to ensure that parents are not congregating outside talking for extended periods of time.

We have had to make some changes to our covid arrangements in school in order to ensure that we are following the latest guidance.

All children in Year 1- Year 6 will remain in the same seat when in the classroom during the school day. We have also had to put the children into set seats at lunchtime in the dinner hall. This information is required by Public Health as if we have a positive case we have to identify the close contacts of the child and seating plans support us with having a clearer idea.

Staff are now wearing masks in communal areas of the school building and all staff who support at lunchtime are wearing a mask in the dinner hall. This is in order to try and minimise the risk further for staff.

Parents' Evenings-

Parents' Evenings will not be able to take place face to face this term. We have been advised by the local authority that this is just not possible. We will therefore be arranging meetings by telephone. Times will be bookable via our usual E-Schools booking system but we will need to stagger these across the school as we only have two phone lines so can't have all the staff calling parents on the same evening(s).
