URGENT: OPAL Donations- Can you help?



Many thanks to all the parents who have managed to drop off some items for our OPAL play project. However, we are desperate for more donations. Currently, we haven't received a lot of donations and ideally every child needs approximately 4 loose parts. So in a school of approximately 200 children we are looking for over 800 parts!

This is an overview of the current list of items that we are looking for. If you are able to donate any of these items, please bring them along to the F2, Y1 & Y2 entrance in the morning from 8:40am- 9:00am. Alternatively, if you can't drop off at these times, please just contact the school office and we will make different arrangements. If you don't have any of these items yourself, please do speak to friends and family members to see if they can help. Any help in securing more of these items would be gratefully received.

- Plastic or metal buckets
- Kitchen utensils, pots, pans, baking trays, sieves, colanders etc for the mud kitchen
- Watering cans, wheel barrows & guttering
- Large pieces of fabric for den building e.g. sheets/curtains/tarpaulin
- Brooms.
- Decorating paintbrushes
- Nets and ropes
- Pegs (to support with setting up dens)
- Suitcases/briefcases
- Cable drums
- Planks of wood e.g. left over pieces from decking etc (please ensure that these do not have nails in them).
- Bamboo poles

Many thanks to all the parents who took the time to fill in the OPAL play questionnaire. We will share with parents the results from this questionnaire in due course and this will provide a baseline for all our OPAL work.

School council- Catering Menus



Our school council have met with Sue (our school cook) to find out about how we can choose our own school food menus for September 2021. Edsential are enabling all schools the opportunity to build their own three weekly menus. The school council have therefore completed a survey with all the children in their class to find out the most popular food choices from the options provided. These choices have been compiled across the school to provide an overview of the most popular menu choices.

Edsential continue to ensure that all homemade biscuit/dessert recipes continue to be reduced by 25% less sugar. Every day the children have access to: Fresh bread, seasonal vegetables, salad, fresh fruit and organic yoghurt.

Edsential have also retained their RSPO accreditation for the use of sustainable palm oil and remain the only school meals catering company to hold this award. All of the menu choices have to meet the requirements of the Food Standards so the menu choices will be checked to ensure they meet these standards.
