The Department for Education have now approved our application for Gayton Primary School to join Cheshire Academies Trust (CAT). Now we have been granted the academy order, we will be working with the local authority, CAT and the DfE in order to complete the conversion process. At the moment, we are aiming for a conversion date of 1st January 2023 but this will depend on the legal process and how long the conversion takes.

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School Census Day- Thursday 6th October 2022 – Information for F2, Y1 and Y2 parents.

On two days, every school year, we have a school census where we complete data about the numbers of children in school and whether they are having a school meal or are eligible for an income based Free School Meal (FSM). Our funding is then paid to us from this information. The money that the school is given in April each year to pay for the free meal, that all Infant School children get under the 'Universal Infant Meals' scheme, is based on the average of how many children have a school meal on Thursday 6th October and Thursday 19th January 2023. We therefore need as many children as possible in F2, Y1 & Y2 to have a school dinner on Thursday 6th October 2022. The kitchen have put together a special 'Best of British' menu and this will be sent home to you.

OPAL (Outdoor play and Learning) parents' meeting

It was lovely to welcome so many parents along to our OPAL (Outdoor play and learning) afternoon. We hope that you found the meeting with our play mentor useful and enjoyed being able to experience a play session with your child. We still have so many plans for our outdoor development and are very grateful to all our parents for their support with this initiative.



We are looking for some parents who would be able to volunteer some of their time during half term on **Monday 24**th **October 2022 from 9:00am- 1:00pm**. We are looking to make some raised beds, some pallet seating and need help to dig out some pathways, amongst other things. If anyone has any power tools/drills

F2- Phonics and Reading information session for parents.

Mrs Such will lead a short session for parents based on how we teach phonics at Gayton using our new Supersonic Phonics programme, whilst the children will be in class with Miss Spearing and then the children will come into the hall so that they can take part in some reading/phonics activities with you.

Wellies/old trainers:

Due to the weather, we are now approaching the period whereby children do need appropriate footwear to play on the field during break times and lunchtimes. Therefore, please can you ensure that your child has wellies or an old pair of trainers in school. They will now not be permitted to go on the field unless they have wellies or old trainers as this also prevents mud/sand and dirt being brought back into school.
